A Before starting any installation project please consider the following:

- Prior to drilling into walls/floors, check there are no hidden electrical wires or cables or water supply pipes with the aid of an electrical detector.
- If you use power tools do not forget:
 - Wear eye protection.
 - Unplug equipment after use.
- This product must not be modified in any way as this will invalidate the guarantee.

INSTALLER GUIDELINES



The installation of these products greatly depends on the floor being level. If this is not the case, it must be corrected before installation.










INSTALLATION OF SHROUDS





Bath shrouds are designed to cover pipework which feeds up from under the floor, to taps and mixers that are fitted or supported by a freestanding roll top bath.

If it is necessary to shorten the shrouds, it must be done from the floor end.

NOTE!

Installation instructions are only a guide. The order in which the installation is carried out may be altered to suit on site conditions.

- I. Identify all components and check for completeness, particularly before arranging fitting. Cover the taps to protect them from damage during installation.
- 2. Loosely arrange the taps or mixer (1) to the bath (2) following their instructions with the washer (3) above the bath and the backnut (4) and washer (3) below the bath.
- 3. Screw the flanges (5) serrated edge uppermost onto the tails of the taps or mixer (1). Screw right up to the backnut (ensuring all thread is covered).
- 4. Locate the pipe inlets under the floorboards and place the floor plates (6) in the desired position. Mark out screw holes, drill and using rawl plugs (10) if necessary, screw the plates to the floor.
- 5. The connector (7) supplied can be brazed onto 22mm pipe work (not supplied) to create the vertical feed through the shroud (8) to the taps or mixer (1). Use a suitable length to allow adequate access to aid assembly and to reach connections below the floor.
- 6. Slide the shrouds (8) over the vertical pipes ensuring sufficient movement to allow connector (7) to reach the tails. Use the washer to create a seal between the tap tails (1) and the connector (7).
- 7. Connect the internal pipework to the water supply under the floorboards using elbows (not supplied), ensuring the pipes have freedom to move up and down.
- 8. Tighten the backnuts (4) of the taps (1) to the bath (2). Turn the taps on and check all connections for leaks.
- 9. Place the shrouds (8) over the floor plates (6) and ensure the flange (5) is secure in the shroud (8) at the top.

Your product should be regularly cleaned with warm water, a mild pH-neutral liquid soap, and polished with a soft cloth. Any residues from soap, toiletries etc. should be rinsed off straight after use.

Household bleaches and cleaners contain harsh chemicals and may damage the surface finish. Avoid using abrasive cloths, scouring pads, scrub sponges, steel wool or anything similar.
