SAFETY NOTES

Please make sure you read these instructions and retain for future use.

All products manufactured by Heritage Bathrooms are safe, providing they are installed and used correctly and also receive maintenance when needed. If you are in doubt about your ability to install this product correctly or safely, you should employ the services of an experienced, qualified plumber.


Consider the following whilst using power tools:

- Prior to drilling into walls, check there are no hidden electrical cables or wires and there are also no water pipes. These can potentially be found using an electrical or metal detector. You may also need to know some of the schematics of previous installations to determine the suitability and accommodation of the installation.
- Wear the correct PPE, especially ear, eye and hand protection when using power tools. Unplug any mains equipment after use.
- Keep electrical equipment away from sources of water.
- If a blow-lamp is used when plumbing, the flame must be kept well away from the product otherwise damage may occur.

The installation of these products greatly depends on the floor being level. If this is not the case, it must be corrected before installation.


This product must not be modified in any way otherwise this will invalidate the guarantee.

PRIOR TO INSTALLATION

The installation of these products greatly depends on the floor being level. If this is not the case, it must be corrected before installation. Identify all components and check for completeness, particularly before arranging fitting. Cover your taps to protect them from damage during installation.



INSTALLATION



Standpipes are designed to support taps or mixers near a freestanding bath and conceal the pipework which feeds up from under the floor to the taps.

Installation instructions are only a guide. The order in which the installation is carried out may be altered to suit on site conditions.

- I. Loosen the grub screws (I) on the standpipes (6), remove the flanges (2) and screw them, large diameter uppermost, onto the tails of the taps or mixer (3), (not supplied). We recommend using a suitable liquid sealant (not supplied) to ensure the tap inlet creates a seal.
- 2. Decide on the positioning of the taps against the bath, making sure the spout reaches.
- 3. Locate the pipe inlets under the floorboards and place the floor plates (5) in the desired position. Mark out the screw holes, drill and using the rawl plugs if necessary, screw the plates (5) to the floor.
- 4. The connector (4) can be brazed onto 22mm pipe work (not supplied) to create the vertical feed through the shroud to the taps or mixer. Use a suitable length to allow sufficient movement to aid assembly and to ease further connections below the floor.
- 5. Slide the standpipes (6) over the vertical pipes ensuring sufficient movement to allow connector (4) to reach the taps or mixer tails. Use the washer (7) to create a seal between the flanges (2) and the standpipes (6).
- 6. Connect the water feed/supply to the vertical pipes (inside the shroud) under the floorboards using elbows (not supplied). Turn the taps on and check all connections for leaks.
- 7. Screw the standpipes to the floor plates (5). Then secure the taps or mixer in position by positioning the shrouds (2) into the top of the standpipes (6) and tightening the grub screws (1).

CARING FOR YOUR PRODUCT

Heritage products are made from premium materials, with hand polished, PVD, EPD or electroplated finishes.

Your product should be regularly cleaned with warm water, a mild pH-neutral liquid soap, and polished with a soft cloth. Any residues from soap, toiletries etc. should be rinsed off straight after use.

Household bleaches and cleaners contain harsh chemicals and may damage the surface finish. Avoid using abrasive cloths, scouring pads, scrub sponges, steel wool or anything similar.

Some surfaces such as nickel and pewter may be affected by the dye found in some cloths, so it is also important to avoid leaving cloths on surfaces.
