

INSTALLATION

Components:

1. Place the waste body (1) and waste rubber washer (2) under the bath. Secure in place by screwing the flange (4) down from the top of the bath, ensuring the silicone washer (3) is underneath it.
2. Push the clicker mechanism (5) into the flange (4). Test that it works correctly by pushing on the button (6) to close, and pushing again for it to pop-up.
3. Place the overflow elbow (9) and overflow rubber washer (10) to the back to the bath. Secure in place by screwing in the overflow face (12), ensuring the grooved washer (11) is in place.
4. The overflow tube (7) uses push-fit connections to secure in place. Push one end on to the overflow elbow (9), ensuring it goes over the O-Ring (8). Push the other end of the hose onto the waste body connection (1), as far as possible.
5. Turn on the water supply and check all joints and connections for leaks.



CARING FOR YOUR PRODUCT

Heritage products are made from premium materials, with hand polishing, PVD, EPD and electroplated finishes.

Your product should be regularly cleaned with warm water, a mild pH-neutral liquid soap, and polished with a soft cloth. Any residues from soap, toiletries etc. should be rinsed off straight after use.

Household bleaches and cleaners contain harsh chemicals and may damage the surface finish. Avoid using abrasive cloths, scouring pads, scrub sponges, steel wool or anything similar.

Some surfaces such as nickel and pewter may be affected by the dye found in some cloths, so it is also important to avoid leaving cloths on surfaces.
