
If power tools are used do not forget to: - Wear eye protection

If you are unsure at all regarding the installation of this product, you should consult a competent person with experience of installing products of this nature.

This instruction is written more to suit the single drawer version of this product because the tolerances are more accurate, for the two door version it is advised to stick with the same tolerances. Draw fitting and Removal is the same.

# **Dimensions**






## Installation

### **Installation Sequence**

- I.'T' off all the hot and cold services at the appropriate position.
- 2. Locate the waste outlets according to the plan.
- 3. Fix the unit to the wall.
- 4. Fit the basin.
- 5. Connect and check the plumbing.

#### **Drawer Removal**

Remove the drawer for ease of installation. Fully extend the drawer out and with a sharp jolt upwards disengage the drawer from the runners (see Fig. I)





When fitting the wall suspension plates (B) use a spirit level to mark a datum line on the wall at the required height. Using the dimensions shown (See Fig. I), fix suspension plates to the wall using suitable fixings for the wall type (not supplied).


To lock the hanging brackets, push the hanging brackets (A) on the unit into the wall suspension plates (B) on the wall (See Fig.2), then with a Phillips screwdriver turn the offset screw on bracket (A) 90 degrees clockwise (See Fig.3).

To tighten the unit to the wall, turn the central screw clockwise on bracket (A) until the carcase is tight to the wall.

Additional screws should be fitted through the back rail into the wall using suitable fixings for the wall type (not supplied).







# Installation & Adjustment

### **Drawer Insertion**

Make sure both runners are pushed all the way into the unit. Place the drawer on the runners and slide towards the back of the unit until the drawer engages onto the runners (See Fig.4)

### Drawer front adjustment and removal

To remove the drawer side cover caps wrap a soft cloth around a flat bladed screwdriver and carefully insert it under the cover cap then twist to remove (See Fig.5)



#### **Drawer handle**

Mark your handle/knob position on the rear face of the drawer. Drill a 1mm pilot hole through from the rear face, then turn over the drawer and drill a 5mm hole through the front face. Fix handle(s) with the screw provided, Note, see the Dimensions for any critical dimensions.
