SAFETY NOTES


Please make sure you read these instructions and retain for future use. All products manufactured by Heritage Bathrooms are safe, providing they are installed and used correctly and also receive maintenance when needed.

Basins, including the connecting water and waste system need to be installed in accordance with and meet the requirements of the Water Supply Regulations 1999 (Water Fittings) and current by-laws. If you are in doubt about your ability to install this product correctly or safely, you should employ the services of an experienced qualified plumber.

This product must not be modified in any way otherwise this will invalidate the guarantee.

Consider the following whilst using power tools:

- Prior to drilling into walls, check there are no hidden electrical cables or wires and there are also no water pipes. These can potentially be found using an electrical or metal detector.
- Wear the correct PPE, especially ear, eye and hand protection when using power tools. Unplug any mains equipment after use.
- Keep electrical equipment away from sources of water.

Please note worktops, taps and wastes are supplied separately. Please follow those fitting instructions for information on how to prepare for installation.




Place your worktop on a soft surface to prevent scratches and damage.

Silicone Sealant



FITTING YOUR BASIN TO YOUR WORKTOP

If tap holes are required, please follow your worktop instructions for more information and installation steps.


Once tapholes have been cut or if they are not required, please follow steps below to complete the installation of your basin.




Insert the threaded screw through the wingnut, metal washer and bracket.

Position the basin onto the chosen worktop. Align basin in place so that there is an even overhang on all edges. (View from the top). The basin overflow should be at the back of the basin/worktop. Using a screwdriver, tighten the threaded screw into one of the predrilled holes in the worktop.

CARING FOR YOUR PRODUCT

Your fitting has a high quality finish and should be treated with care to preserve the surface.

- All surface finishes will wear if not cleaned correctly.
- The only safe way to clean your product is to wipe with a soft damp cloth. Any stains can be removed using washing up liquid.
- Do not use cleaning powders or liquids.
- Even non-scratch cleaners may damage the surface of your fitting.
- Avoid liquids that are likely to stain, if liquids are spilt they should be cleaned immediately.
