# INTRODUCTION

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## SAFETY NOTES



Please read these instructions and retain for future use.

All products manufactured and supplied by Heritage are safe, provided they are installed correctly, used correctly, and receive regular maintenance in accordance with these instructions.

If you are in any doubt about your ability to install this product safely you must employ the services of a competent person who has experience of fitting products of this nature.



Before starting any installation project please consider the following:

- Prior to drilling into walls, check there are no hidden electrical wires, cables or water supply pipes with the aid of an electrical detector.
- If you use power tools do not forget PPE:
  - Wear eye protection.
  - Unplug equipment after use.
- Keep electrical equipment away from sources of water.
- This product must not be modified in any way as this will invalidate the guarantee.
- · Basins, including the connecting water and waste system need to be installed in accordance with and meet the requirements of the water supply regulations 1999 (Water Fittings) and Scottish By-Laws 2004.
- If a blow lamp is used when plumbing, the flame must be kept away from the furniture otherwise damage may occur.
- All units should be assembled and fitted using instructions and installation guidelines provided. Any screws and other fixings used must be suitable for the installation situation. (Brick, Block, Plaster or Dot & Dab)

Saftey Notice- All Wall Hung Units must be installed with adequate load bearing screws (not supplied) and used with the supplied wall hung brackets and plates.

### INSTALLER GUIDELINES



The furniture in this booklet comes mostly assembled.

Things to assemble are shelves and single doors


The installation of this product greatly depends on the floor being level. If this is not the case, it must be corrected before installation.

Keep an eye out for the 'INSTALLER TIPS' throughout the instructions for helpful advice.

# INSTALLATION SEQUENCE



WE RECOMMEND THAT YOU POSITION ALL OF YOUR FURNITURE IN THE DESIRED RUN, MAKING SURE THAT ITS ALL LEVEL AND SAME HEIGHT BEFORE SECURING TO WALL




- 1 'T' off hot and cold water appropriately
- Locate waste outlets according to plan
- Fix base units to the wall
- 4 Fit countertop
- 5 Fit sanitaryware

- 6 Check all connections for leaks
- 7 Fit wall cupboards where appropriate
- 8 Fit Bridge and Cornice (Bridge Lights)
- 9 Fit continuous plinth if used, scribing as necessary.
- 10 Fit Handles and make any hinge adjustments

## INSTALLATION - WC & CISTERN UNIT

# **INSTALLER TIPS**


If other base units are being fitted we recommend that the WC unit fascia is measured first to determine the height for all other furniture.



#### **WC UNIT**

Caversham


WC Unit fascia is pre-cut, however additional cutting may be required dependent on the chosen range.



# **IMPORTANT**

In some cases it may be necessary to fix the cistern to an additional batten screwed to the

rear wall.




#### **CONCEALED CISTERN**

Caversham The cistern push button should be installed in

the upper fascia, measure the button before cutting.


Allow at least 85mm from the side edge of the fascia, to enable it to be reversed if necessary. It should be mounted centrally within the furniture at 800mm (floor to the top of the cistern lid)




Secure legs to the holders.
To adjust height of legs
turn the bottom leg to
increase/decrease

We recommend that you position all of your furniture in the desired run, making sure that its all level and same height before securing to wall

# VANITY UNITS Caversham


Position vanity unit against the wall at required height, using a spirit level to check before securing to the wall. Please note that suitable wall fixings should be sourced by the installer. Refer to the fitting instructions for the semi-recessed basin before completely fitting the vanity unit to the wall



#### **OPEN BASE UNITS**


Position the open unit next to the neighbouring unit and check level. Holes for the shelf pins are pre-drilled and the support pins are supplied with the base units

Pre-fitted leg holders
Positions of leg holders
will vary on open base
units and WC units.




# **INSTALLER TIPS**

You can adjust and remove the drawers if needed. Follow instructions on this page.



#### DRAWER UNITS


Fit legs see installer tips on page 6.
Position the drawer units next to the neighbouring unit and check level. The drawers for the drawer unit come assembled and the runners are fitted.



#### **BASE UNITS**


Position base unit against the wall at required height, use a spirit level to check that the unit is plumb and level. Drill two holes through the back panel evenly spaced approx 50mm down from the top edge of back panel. Fix to wall using suitable fixings (Not Supplied). Holes for the shelf pins are pre-drilled and the support

Holes for the shelf pins are pre-drilled and the support pins are supplied with the base units



#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

'L' shaped brackets are supplied with the base units for you to secure your worktop.



## INSTALLATION - WALL UNITS



## **IMPORTANT**

Suitable load bearing screws and additional screws must be used to secure the lower part of the wall units to the wall.

(Additional screws are not supplied)


#### FLOOR TOWER UNIT

If you are fitting a floor tower unit into your run this should be used to determine the height of your other wall units. Please use suitable screws to secure the tower unit to the wall.


Secure the unit to the wall in 3 locations through the back panel, we suggest at the top and bottom of the unit and a stabilising screw in the middle of unit.

We recommend that you use the loose shelves to cover the screws. Once wall unit secured to the wall using suitable fixings put in place the shelves

# **INSTALLER TIPS**



The wall units are supplied with suspension fittings that are pre-fitted to the back of the unit. The wall hanging brackets will be supplied joined together, you will need to seperate them by snapping them apart. Hold eitherside of bracket and gently snap them apart.




# WALL UNIT

Locate the wall units in position and mark up where they will be secured to the wall. Using the Installer Tips above, Fix the supplied wall plates, using appropriate load bearing screws that are suitable for the wall material (Screws are not supplied)

Fix to the wall at the desired height, making sure that there is enough of the fixing protruding to hang suspension fitting on.

Additional screws must be used to secure the lower part of the wall units to the wall. (Additional screws not supplied)

We recommend that you use the loose shelves to cover the screws. Once wall unit secured to the wall using suitable fixings put in place the shelves



## INSTALLATION - WALL UNITS




Saftey Notice-All Wall Hung Units must be installed with adequate load bearing screws (not supplied) and used with the supplied wall hung brackets and plates.

#### MIRROR WALL UNIT

Fix appropriate fixings to the wall at the desired height, making sure that there is enough of the fixing protruding to hang the suspension fitting on.

Additional screws must be used to secure the lower part of the wall units to the wall. (Additional screws not supplied)



#### SIT ON WALL UNIT


Locate the wall units in position and mark up where they will be secured to the wall.

Using the Installer tips on p.8, Fix the supplied wall plates, using appropriate load bearing screws that are suitable for the wall material (Screws are not supplied) making sure that there is enough of the fixing protruding to hang the suspension fitting on.

When fitting the sit on wall unit, please check that you have left enough room for the worktop to fit between the base unit and wall unit.


Additional screws must be used to secure the lower part of the wall units to the wall. (Additional screws not supplied)

We recommend that you use the loose shelves to cover the screws. Once wall unit secured to the wall using suitable fixings put in place the shelves




A PULLS INTO WALL

# DOOR ADJUSTMENT





#### DOOR/ HINGE FIXINGS

Clip the hinge into the front of the mounting plate on inside of unit first before pushing the back of the hinge against the plate it clips into position.

Adjust the door as required- see Hinge Adjustment diagram.

#### SINGLE DOOR/ HINGE FIXINGS

Note on single door units that the doors can be reversed. Fit the hinge plates on the desired side of the unit. Use the covers provided to cover the original hinge plate holes.


Adjust the door as required- see Hinge Adjustment diagram.

## HINGE ADJUSTMENT


To adjust the doors side to side tighten/ loosen screw I

To adjust the door forwards and backwards tighten/loosen screw 2

To adjust the door up and down adjust screws 3 on the mounting plate.









Once all your wall units are fitted and secure, you can complete the look by adding a Bridge and Cornice on top of unit. The bridge can be screwed down onto the wall unit, keeping in mind the length of the screw going into the top of the unit.

The cornice can be fitted directly on top of units without a bridge and should be secured using screws (Not supplied) Drill screws down directly on the lip of the cornice into the top of the units, please make sure you use the correct size screw.









FITTING YOUR BASE UNIT PLINTH

Measure the required length for your plinth and allow for extra for return ends. If a return end is being fitted this should be done before securing the front plinths, as you need to be able to screw the return end plinth to base unit.

The base units and vanity units have pre-drilled pilot holes on the underneath of the units, appropriate fixing brackets are supplied and should be fitted to suit your furniture.

The front plinth should have the supplied support clips attached and then secured to the base unit legs.


Fixing screws for the return end plinth are supplied


The support clips are supplied flat you will need to seperate the two parts and assemble before securing to plinth

to base unit legs






#### WC PLINTH

The continous plinth should sit behind the WC fascia, no clips will be required as the WC unit legs are set further back, surrounding unit support clips will keep plinth secure behind the fascia.

Additional cutting may be required to allow for the soil pipe





#### TALL GABLE END

The Floor Tower Unit Gable end screw directly through the side panel of adjacent unit into the gable end.


Check all units are level before finally securing the place.

Screws not supplied for the Tall Gable and Gable ends.

#### **GABLE END**

The Base Units have a gable end to suit them, these help to define the end of a furniture run.

Screw directly through the side panel of adjacent unit into the gable end. Check all units are level before finally securing the place.



#### **BASE FILLER**

The Base Fillers are available to help fill space between or at the ends of run if gaps need to be concealed, the base filler should sit in line of base unit carcass, and should sit on top of the plinth.

The base filler can be cut to suit your space.


### **IMPORTANT**

Make sure that the length of screws will not damage the internal or external panels






#### BASE FILLER CONTINUED....



We suggest that the base fillers are secured using 'L' shaped brackets (not supplied)
Suitable brackets and screws

Suitable brackets and screws should be sourced by the installer


## **INSTALLER TIPS**



For all finishes place the door on a firm flat piece of clean scrap material.


### **GOOD TO KNOW**

Door buffers are supplied.
Fit to furniture doors
once all installed.



# Finishing touches HANDLES

Mark the handle position you require and drill a Imm pilot hole through from the face of the door, turn over the door and drill a 5mm hole through. Fix the handle(s) with the screw(s) provided
