INTRODUCTION

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SAFETY NOTES

Please make sure you read these instructions and retain for future use.

All products manufactured by Heritage Bathrooms are safe, providing they are installed and used correctly and also receive maintenance when needed.

Baths, including the connecting water and waste system need to be installed in accordance with and meet the requirements of the Water Supply Regulations 1999 (Water Fittings) and current by-laws. If you are in doubt about your ability to install this product correctly or safely, you should employ the services of an experienced qualified plumber.

This product must not be modified in any way otherwise this will invalidate the guarantee.

Consider the following whilst using power tools:

- Prior to drilling into walls, check there are no hidden electrical cables or wires and there are also no water pipes. These can potentially be found using an electrical or metal detector. You may also need to know some of the schematics of previous installations to determine the suitability and accommodation of the installation.
- Wear the correct PPE, especially ear, eye and hand protection when using power tools. Unplug any mains equipment after use.
- Keep electrical equipment away from sources of water.
- If a blow-lamp is used when plumbing, the flame must be kept well away from the product otherwise damage may occur.

PRIOR TO INSTALLATION


Please ensure that the installation and accommodation is designed with future serviceability of the product in mind. In the event a future claim is made under the product warranty, the design of the installation may affect compensation costs if it has not been considered in the original design.

Check the installation and dimensions of your basin to make sure that the exposed pipework will fit to your basin. Consideration will need to be taken for the clearance underneath the basin, space available in any fitted furniture and the depth of the basin to the waste pipework location. The horizontal waste pipe may need to be cut to size to suit the installation.

Failure to observe crucial information in these fitting instructions will nullify your guarantee.

This product requires experience within plumbing. No responsibility will be taken for poor workmanship resulting in leaks and injuries.

Crucial Dimensions




INSTALLATION

Components:

Identify all components are present prior to installation.

- I. Unscrew the locking nuts (3) from the waste body (I) to reveal the vertical pipe (5).
- 2. Arrange the two locking nuts (3) on to the vertical pipe (5) with the threads pointing outwards, facing opposite ways. Make sure the rubber washer (2) is in place and screw down the lower locking nut (3).
- 3. Connect the waste body (I) by pushing the vertical pipe (5) into the basin waste (not supplied). Secure using the upper locking nut (3), ensuring the washer (4) is in place.
- 4. Push the horizontal pipe (8) into the waste pipework (not supplied). Loosen the lower locking nut (3) and adjust the height of the trap so that the waste body (I) lines up with the horizontal pipe (8). Secure in place by tightening the lower locking nut (3).
- 5. Mark on the horizontal pipe (8) where it meets the waste body (I), allowing for clearance. If necessary, cut the horizontal pipe to size, removing all debris and deburring any rough edges. Be careful of the plated finish.
- 6. Place the shroud (9) over horizontal pipe (8) and connect to the waste pipework (1 1/4" BSP not supplied). Secure the pipe (8) in place using the tapered washer (7) and horizontal nut (6).
- 7. Turn on the water supply and check all joints and connections for leaks.

NOTES



CARING FOR YOUR PRODUCT

Heritage products are made from premium materials, with hand polishing, PVD, EPD and electroplated finishes.

Your product should be regularly cleaned with warm water, a mild pH-neutral liquid soap, and polished with a soft cloth. Any residues from soap, toiletries etc. should be rinsed off straight after use.

Household bleaches and cleaners contain harsh chemicals and may damage the surface finish. Avoid using abrasive cloths, scouring pads, scrub sponges, steel wool or anything similar.

Some surfaces such as nickel and pewter may be affected by the dye found in some cloths, so it is also important to avoid leaving cloths on surfaces.
