SAFETY NOTES

Please make sure you read these instructions and retain for future use.

All products manufactured by Heritage Bathrooms are safe, providing they are installed and used correctly and also receive maintenance when needed.

Basins, including the connecting water and waste system need to be installed in accordance with and meet the requirements of the water supply regulations 1999 (Water Fittings) and Scottish By-Laws 2004. If you are in doubt about your ability to install this product correctly or safely, you should employ the services of an experienced qualified plumber.

This product must not be modified in any way otherwise this will invalidate the guarantee.

Consider the following whilst using power tools:

- Prior to drilling into walls, check there are no hidden electrical cables or wires and there are also no water pipes. These can potentially be found using an electrical or metal detector. You may also need to know some of the schematics of previous installations to determine the suitability and accommodation of the installation.
- Wear the correct PPE, especially ear, eye and hand protection when using power tools. Unplug any mains equipment after use.
- Keep electrical equipment away from sources of water.
- If a blow-lamp is used when plumbing, the flame must be kept well away from the product otherwise damage may occur.

Basins can be very heavy; a lifting aid or second person at minimum will be required to manoeuvre safely. Ensure the surface the product is being fitted to has enough reinforcement to support the weight of the basin.

PRIOR TO INSTALLATION

Consider and plan the installation of your basin taps and waste whilst installing this basin. The waste may have to be pre-fitted before fitting to the worktop. Careful planning is also required to ensure the waste and water supply pipes can reach connection points, and that the spout projection will reach the basin once installed. Hole sizes will need to be cut and measured accurately in order to correctly fit to your worktop - the cutting size for the basin has been provided.


Installing this product requires experience within plumbing. No responsibility will be taken for poor workmanship resulting in leaks and injuries. Please ensure that the installation and accommodation is designed with future serviceability of the product in mind. It is strongly advisable to fit isolation valves before the water fixtures in case isolation is required at any point during maintenance.




The installation of this product greatly depends on the floor being level. If this is not the case, it must be corrected before installation. All units, worktops, and other fittings should be assembled and fitted using the instructions and installation guidelines provided with them.




VESSEL BASIN Redford, Berkhamsted & Keymer

Plan your installation, with the placement of the basin and taps on to your worktop. Ensure all tails and waste pipework can reach the planned connection locations, and the projection of the spout will reach the basin. **NOTE** - The basin shown in these instructions are for illustration purposes only. All products in this range can be fitted using these instructions. If your unit has drawers, consider the location of the waste cut out(s) in the drawer(s) whilst planning your basin installation.

Cutting Hole Size:







Refer to your worktop instructions to cut the holes in your worktop. The floor/furniture should be level to aid with the installation of your basin.





Take care when adjusting the basin position to avoid scratching the worktop. Any cut outs must be sealed to prevent water ingress!





CARING FOR YOUR PRODUCT

Your basin should be regularly cleaned with warm water, a mild pH-neutral liquid soap, and polished with a soft cloth. Any residues from soap, toiletries etc. should be rinsed off straight after use.

Household bleaches and cleaners contain harsh chemicals and may damage the surface finish. Avoid using abrasive cloths, scouring pads, scrub sponges, steel wool or anything similar.

Do not slide objects along your worktop as this may scratch/damage the surface. Take care when adjusting the tap and basin position to avoid damage/scratching the worktop.

Occasionally wipe the worktop surface with a soft damp cloth and dry with a soft dry cloth. Wipe away any spillages and excess moisture immediately. Do not use any abrasive cleaning agents or materials, these will change the surface condition from the standard finish.
